

How to Save Seeds

A Step-by-Step Guide: *Lettuce*



1. Once your lettuce plants have sent up their flower stalks, the seeds will begin to ripen.
2. Once the stalks are dryish and are producing dandelion-like fluff, you know the seeds have ripened to maturity.
3. To collect the seeds, shake the stalk over a paper bag or bucket (Do over a couple of days or all at once depending on how ready the seeds are).
4. Gently remove fluff from seeds.
5. Put the seeds into an envelope, then date and label it.
6. Drop seeds off at the service desk at Niagara-on-the-Lake Public Library to share with the community next year!
